The Recreation Department is pleased to once again offer Wayne residents an opportunity to utilize our twelve (12) lighted asphalt tennis courts located on Nellis Drive.

Enclosed please find the 2010 registration cards and regulations for the use of the Wayne Municipal Tennis Courts. Proof of residency is required upon registration. If submitted check has your Wayne address, that will suffice as proof of residency. If your check does not have a Wayne address, please enclose a copy of current driver's license or utility bill. We have enclosed a form for our popular children/adult tennis lessons for your convenience.

Please Note: THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ISSUED FOR ANY REASON, FOR BADGES OR CANCELLED LESSONS, UNLESS THE CLASS IS CANCELLED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & RECREATION.

Please fill out the enclosed registration card on BOTH sides and mail it to the Department of Parks and Recreation, 475 Valley Road, Wayne, New Jersey 07470. Please make your check or money order payable to Township of Wayne. It is very important that you include your phone number on the membership application.

Please call 973-694-1800 ext. 3258 for more information regarding the tennis program. The tennis court phone number is 973-628-1044.

Note: THERE WILL BE A \$20.00 CHARGE FOR ANY CHECK RETURNED FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS.

Your numbered badge will be sent to you by return mail and will entitle you to tennis and platform tennis court privileges. A current tennis badge is required to use the platform tennis courts.

Our office hours are 8:30 A.M. to 4:15 P.M. Monday thru Friday and Tuesday from 8:30 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. If you wish to pay in cash you must come to the recreation office with the exact amount for your membership, as change is NOT available. Badges may not be purchased at the tennis courts. **Private Tennis Lessons are strictly prohibited, unless authorized by the Department of Parks and Recreation.**

Tennis fees are as follows:

**RULES FOR USE OF THE COURTS**

TENNIS SNEAKERS OR RUBBER SOLED GYMNASIUM SHOES WITHOUT HEELS MUST BE WORN.

**BADGE HOLDERS MUST REPORT TO THE TENNIS HUT AND CHECK IN WITH ATTENDANT BEFORE TAKING COURT.**

WHEN OTHERS ARE WAITING TO PLAY, NO ONE MAY USE A COURT LONGER THAN ONE HOUR.

GUESTS MUST PLAY WITH A BADGE HOLDER. ANYONE TRANSFERRING OR LOANING THEIR BADGE WILL LOSE ALL PRIVILEGES FOR ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF INFRACTION.

HOURS AND DATES AVAILABLE FOR PLAY SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPT. OF PARKS AND RECREATION.

LIGHTS ARE NORMALLY ON FROM LATE APRIL THROUGH THE END OF SEPTEMBER UNTIL 10:00 P.M. - WEATHER PERMITTING.

ADULTS HAVE PREFERENCE MONDAY-SATURDAY, 6:00 P.M. TILL CLOSING AND ALL DAY SUNDAY.

CHILDREN MAY BE BUMPED WHILE WAITING FOR A COURT DURING ADULT PREFERENCE TIME. HOWEVER, ONCE THEY ARE ON A COURT THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPLETE THEIR HOUR OF PLAY.

PLEASE DISCARD CHEWING GUM, SODA CANS, TOPS TO TENNIS CANS, ETC. IN THE PROPER CONTAINER. DEBRIS AND GUM CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE COURTS.

PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE COURTS. BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLER BLADING STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
