



ALL FACILITY AND JAMES W. ROE MEMORIAL POOL – 2011

We would like to welcome everybody back to our Family Aquatic Center that opened to our residents in 2006. This facility offers a zero depth entrance that is child and handicapped friendly; a separate tot pool; a flume slide and drop slide; a diving board; a dedicated swim lane; and an interactive water play area. This Award-Winning facility has been very well received by our members and we have continued to implement suggestions made by our members to help further improve the daily operation of the site. **To that end we have purchased more new chaise lounges and additional portable chairs that will be available for use throughout the facility.**

The swim facilities will open Saturday, May 28th and close Monday, September 5th.

The photo I.D. system installed in 2006 allowed us to better identify our patrons and keep our facilities for members only. This system will continue in use in 2011. **Photo ID's issued in previous years will be validated for 2011 upon payment of fees; new badges will not be mailed. Photo ID's older than 3 years will be updated at no charge-new pictures are required. OLD BADGES MUST BE RETURNED TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION OFFICE BEFORE NEW BADGES ARE ISSUED.**

If you were a member last year you only need to send in a photocopy of your current valid driver's license and a copy of a current electric, telephone bill or similar to re-register. If you need to have your photos updated you will need to come in or send new **current** photos and your old ID's. You must fill out all information on the registration form every year (form enclosed).

If you were not a member last year you will need to come to Town Hall with all your family members to have your pictures taken, **or** you can send a **current color photo (no hats or sunglasses)** for each individual in your family (**no family photos**) to the Recreation Department. Proof of residence for all family members (copy of driver's license, **plus** a copy of a current electric or telephone bill or similar), and copies of birth certificates for all children (regardless of age) will be required. We realize that getting everyone together to have their pictures taken will be somewhat of a challenge for some families, but it is a step we need to take to better oversee membership. To help accommodate you and make the process a little easier, we will be available on several evenings so that you can come to the Municipal Building with all family members to have your pictures taken. Remember to bring copies of your children's birth certificates and all other required information with you. Of course, you may also come to the Recreation Department anytime Monday-Friday with your entire family from 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to get your pictures and ID's or you can send in current photos to avoid having to come into the office for picture taking. **We are also open every Tuesday evening until 7:00 p.m. and can process your registration.**

We are pleased to announce that the Brownstone will be running the concession again this year.

Guest cards will again be available this year; they can only be purchased at the Recreation Department. Guest cards can be used the same as guest books were and are available as a four pass card, six pass card and 10 pass card. Each card will be valid for this season and for two additional seasons as long as you continue your membership. Each time you bring a guest to the facility the card will be swiped. When you reach your limit (4, 6 or 10 guests) the card will no longer be valid. Members will only be allowed to purchase a total of 20 guest passes this year. **Guests are not permitted on holiday weekends (Memorial Day and Labor Day – Saturday, Sunday and Monday and July 2nd, 3rd, and 4th).**

Please be sure to fill out the enclosed forms completely and mail them in with your photos and other required documents or bring them with you when you come in to register. **Please read enclosed literature carefully for registration requirements. The enclosed form can be used to register for the Pool or All Facility membership. Please fill out the proper section.**

Special evening registration dates in the Recreation Department:

Tuesdays, May 10th, May 17th and May 24th - 4:30-7:30 p.m.

Although we will process registration and take photos as quickly as possible on these evenings you may experience some delays, especially as we get closer to the opening date of the facilities. Avoid the lines. REGISTER EARLY!!!!

NOTE: Kilroy will open weekends and holidays only until Wednesday, June 22nd. Both facilities will close on Monday, Sept. 5th.

Only members can purchase and use guest PASSES. Remember, members must accompany their guests at all times when they are at the facility. **THE USE OF GUEST PASSES AT THE POOL WILL BE LIMITED TO FOUR PER FAMILY PER DAY.** Guest passes for 2011 **WILL NOT** be accepted on Holiday weekends. REMEMBER, GUEST PASSES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Lost guest cards will HAVE A FEE TO BE replaced. Please familiarize yourself with the enclosed rules and regulations and the restrictions regarding guests. Members will be limited to 20 guest passes per year.

There will be a \$20.00 charge for any check returned for insufficient funds.

Wayne Township photo ID's are non-transferable. People giving false information on their application will nullify swimming privileges for the unit of membership for two weeks, and those who give false Wayne addresses will lose their entire registration. No one will be admitted to the pool without his/her ID. Those families purchasing "All Facility Memberships" will use their photo ID's at either facility.

NOTE: Please keep your ID's at the end of the season. If you register in 2012 your photo ID will be re-validated.
A fee will be charged for families that require Replacement Badges.

ALL WAYNE TOWNSHIP SWIM FACILITIES ARE SMOKE FREE AS PER TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE.

ALL CHILDREN THAT ARE NOT POTTY TRAINED WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR SWIM DIAPERS WITH RUBBER PANTS OVER THEM WHEN USING THE POOLS.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

HOURS OF OPERATION:

MONDAY-FRIDAY POOL OPENS AT 12 NOON

WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS POOL OPENS AT 11:00 A.M.

THIS IS A SMOKE FREE FACILITY – SMOKING IS PROHIBITED

- GUEST CARDS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND ARE ONLY AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT THE RECREATION OFFICE. GUEST CARDS ARE VALID FOR THE SEASON PURCHASED AND TWO ADDITIONAL SEASONS AFTER PURCHASE AS LONG AS MEMBERSHIP IS RENEWED.
- USE OF GUEST PASSES ARE LIMITED TO FOUR (4)-PER DAY, PER FAMILY. MEMBER FAMILIES MAY BRING UP TO FOUR (4) ADDITIONAL GUESTS INTO THE FACILITY ON WEEKDAYS (EXCLUDING HOLIDAYS) BY PAYING THE FULL DAILY GUEST FEE. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- MEMBER FAMILIES WILL BE ALLOWED TO PURCHASE A MAXIMUM OF 20 GUEST PASSES PER SEASON.
- GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER AT ALL TIMES WHEN THEY ARE USING THE FACILITIES. MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR GUESTS.
- ALL GUESTS WILL BE PROHIBITED ON SATURDAY, SUNDAY AND MONDAY OF MEMORIAL DAY AND LABOR DAY WEEKENDS AND ON JULY 2ND, 3RD AND 4TH.
- REFUNDS WILL ONLY BE ISSUED FOR A GUEST IF THEY HAVE BEEN IN THE FACILITY FOR LESS THAN ONE HOUR BEFORE A RAIN STORM THAT CAUSES THE CLOSING OF THE FACILITY.
- NO RUNNING, PUSHING OR HORSEPLAY ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE POOL.
- **NO JUMPING OR DIVING OFF THE DECK OR JUMPING BACKWARDS FROM THE DIVING BOARD.**
- DIVING IS ONLY ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED AREAS.
- DIVERS MUST WAIT FOR PREVIOUS DIVER TO SWIM TO THE POOLSIDE LADDER BEFORE DIVING. ONE PERSON ON THE DIVING BOARD AT A TIME.
- ONLY ONE BOUNCE OFF THE DIVING BOARD. **NO FLIPS ALLOWED.**
- SWIMMERS USING THE DIVING BOARD MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM WITH THEIR ARMS OUT OF THE WATER. IN THE EVENT THAT A LIFEGUARD DOES NOT FEEL THAT A SWIMMER IS STRONG ENOUGH TO SWIM IN THE DEEP WATER, THAT SWIMMER WILL BE ASKED TO PASS A DEEP WATER TEST TO INCLUDE: 2 LAPS OF OVERHAND STROKE.
- LAP SWIMMING FOR ADULTS WILL BE PROVIDED MONDAY AND FRIDAY MORNINGS BETWEEN 10:45-11:45AM. THIS MAY BE INCREASED TO ADDITIONAL MORNINGS IF STAFF IS AVAILABLE. **LAP SWIMMING WILL BEGIN AND END WITH SWIM LESSON DATES.**
- USE OF THE LAP LANE WILL BE LIMITED TO ADULTS ONLY MON-FRI FOR ONE HALF HOUR AT THE TOP OF EACH HOUR BEGINNING AT 3PM. (ex. 3-3:30, 4-4:30, 5-5:30 etc.) AND FROM 6PM TO CLOSING DAILY.
- **AN INDIVIDUAL MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM ONE COMPLETE LAP TO USE THE LAP LANE.**
- THE ROPED OFF AREA IN THE 4' SECTION OF THE POOL WILL BE LIMITED TO ADULT USE ONLY.
- NO TOYS, BALL PLAYING OR THROWING ANY OBJECTS IN THE POOL.
- NO TOSSING CHILDREN OR SITTING ON SOMEONE'S SHOULDERS.
- ONLY U.S. COAST GUARD APPROVED FLOATATION DEVICES ALLOWED IN THE POOL.

- NO SITTING OR HANGING ON THE LANE LINES OR LADDERS.
- NO CLIMBING ON THE LIFEGUARD STANDS, OR ANY UNNECESSARY TALKING TO GUARDS WHILE THE GUARD IS ON DUTY.
- ENTERING THE FACILITY AFTER HOURS IS PROHIBITED.
- FIRST AID EQUIPMENT IS TO BE USED BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY.
- PATRONS WITH OPEN SORES OR RASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL.
- SNORKELS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL. GOGGLES AND MASKS ARE PERMITTED, HOWEVER, NO MASKS ARE ALLOWED OFF THE DIVING BOARD OR SLIDES.
- IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF PARENTS TO WATCH THEIR CHILDREN IN THE SAND BOX AND KIDDIE POOL. A LIFEGUARD (WHEN AVAILABLE) WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE KIDDIE POOL TO MAINTAIN ORDER AND TO INSURE SAFETY.
- NO WATER ALLOWED IN THE SANDBOX.
- **WHEN A GUARD'S WHISTLE IS BLOWN IT IS FOR A REASON AND EVERYONE IN THE FACILITY SHOULD HONOR IT FOR SAFETY REASONS. WE WANT EVERYONE TO KNOW WHAT IS GOING ON IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY.**
- **LIFEGUARD WHISTLE CODES ARE AS FOLLOWS:**
 - **1 SHORT BLAST - TO GET THE ATTENTION OF A SWIMMER.**
 - **2 SHORT BLASTS - A GUARD IS LEAVING HIS/HER STAND FOR A RESCUE.**
 - **1 LONG BLAST - TO CLEAR THE WATER.**
- PATRONS MUST WEAR PROPER SWIM ATTIRE. (NO SHIRTS OR BOXER SHORTS IN POOL).
- ALL TODDLERS AND CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT POTTY TRAINED WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR SWIM DIAPERS, WITH RUBBER PANTS COVERING THEM, ALONG WITH A BATHING SUIT. NO DIAPERS (except swim diapers) ARE ALLOWED IN POOLS!!!!!!
- DISROBING OR DIAPER CHANGING IS ONLY ALLOWED IN THE LOCKER ROOMS.
- LOCKERS AVAILABLE – REGISTER AT THE POOL OFFICE. YOU MUST SUPPLY YOUR OWN LOCK.
- **CHILDREN UNDER 13 YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR RESPONSIBLE ADULT 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO USE THE FACILITY.**
- THE PAVED PARKING AREA IS PROVIDED FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING AND FAMILIES WITH STROLLERS. PLEASE COOPERATE.
- SPITTING, SPOUTING WATER OR BLOWING YOUR NOSE IN THE WATER IS PROHIBITED.
- ID'S ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE. THEY BELONG TO THE MEMBER THAT THEY WERE ISSUED TO AND NO ONE ELSE.
- NOTE: MEMBERSHIP ID'S ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES FOR ENTRANCE INTO THE FACILITY.
- RECREATION SUPPLIES ARE TO BE ENJOYED BY THE ENTIRE MEMBERSHIP. PLEASE DO NOT KEEP SUPPLIES FOR AN EXTENDED LENGTH OF TIME.
- RECREATION SUPPLIES ARE AVAILABLE ONLY TO THOSE WHO POSSESS A MEMBERSHIP BADGE. GUEST BADGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- NO TOY WHISTLES MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE FACILITY.
- PROFANITY, IMPROPER BEHAVIOR, INTOXICATION AND VULGAR REMARKS ARE PROHIBITED.

- LOUNGE CHAIRS ARE FOR ADULTS ONLY ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS AND MAY NOT BE RESERVED. LIMITED TO ONE LOUNGE PER ADULT.
- SAVING OF CHAIRS/LOUNGES IS NOT ALLOWED. TOWELS LEFT ON UNATTENDED LOUNGE CHAIRS WILL BE REMOVED AND PLACED IN THE LOST AND FOUND OR MANAGER'S OFFICE.
- HEADPHONES MUST BE USED WITH ALL PERSONAL RADIOS/IPODS.
- PATRONS MUST SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL, ESPECIALLY AFTER LEAVING THE PLAYGROUND AREA.
- FOOD AND DRINKS ARE PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. PROHIBITED IN POOL AREA.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED IN FACILITY. (COOLERS WILL BE CHECKED AT THE GATE).
- CHEWING GUM IS PROHIBITED ANYWHERE IN THE FACILITY.
- ONLY NON-DISPOSABLE CUPS ARE ALLOWED OFF THE PATIO OR PICNIC AREAS.
- GARBAGE MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN PROPER RECEPTACLES. PLEASE USE RECYCLING CONTAINERS.
- PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE FACILITY.

PARENTS: FREQUENTLY REMIND YOUR CHILDREN TO MONITOR THEIR BATHROOM NEEDS. PARENTS SHOULD REQUIRE THAT THEIR CHILDREN USE THE RESTROOMS BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL TO PREVENT "ACCIDENTS" FROM OCCURING.

NOTE: IN ORDER TO HELP REDUCE ACCIDENTS ALL CHILDREN AGE 6 AND UNDER WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE POOL FOR 10 MINUTES EVERY 2 HOURS FOR BATHROOM BREAKS.

CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES WHEN USING THE FACILITY.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS AT ANY TIME MAY LEAD TO EJECTION FROM THE FACILITY, OR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES.

POOL/ALL FACILITY 2011 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

ALL MEMBERS MUST HAVE A PHOTO I.D.

MEMBERS MUST SHOW THEIR PHOTO ID'S TO ENTER THE FACILITY.

VIOLATION OF ADOPTED RULES MAY RESULT IN REVOCATION OF FACILITY MEMBERSHIP.

We strongly recommend that you send in photos and required documents by mail to avoid having to wait on line during evening registrations. Please allow a minimum of 5 business days for processing applications by mail. Those families who have membership passes from 2010 need only submit proof of residency and appropriate fees.

2010 ID's will be **re-validated** and used again this year. If you do not have last year's badges, you will need to pay a fee to have new badges issued. If you want to update pictures on your old badges, you must send in your old badges and the new photos.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY: (REQUIRED EVERY YEAR)

Proof of residency is required for all applicants. Please include a copy of your current electric, gas or telephone bill (renters may submit a copy of their current lease) and second proof, driver's license, or major credit card statement. All individuals 18 to 23 years of age that are part of your family must submit a copy of their driver's license or other identification in addition to their birth certificate. Birth Certificates are required for initial registration only.

MAIL-IN REGISTRATION:

1. Complete application form enclosed and mail back with check and/or money order payable to: Wayne Township.
2. Mail in a clear and quality individual color photo-**current photo only** (no sunglasses or hats). Family photos will not be accepted. Each person must submit his/her own individual photo. Please mark the back of the photo with the name of the individual. We will scan the photo onto membership card(s). You may pick up your photo I.D.'s at the Recreation Office after approximately 5 business days or at the pool beginning opening day. For security purposes, photo I.D.'s will not be mailed.
NOTE: One photo for each registered individual. Children under 1 year of age (age as of May 1st) do not need a membership I.D. but should be listed on your membership form.
3. All children age 1-23 require a birth certificate copy or if you are age 62 or older and applying for senior citizen membership, proof of age is required (copy of driver's license, etc.). NOTE: All children 18 years of age and over must also provide a copy of their driver's license in addition to their birth certificate to verify residency.
4. Incomplete applications will be returned to sender and will delay processing.

WALK-IN REGISTRATION: We may not be able to process I.D.'s the same day. Do not delay. Register Now!

1. Proof of residency required- see above.
2. Proof of age required see #3 above.

Family membership includes **husband, wife** and **all unmarried children 23 years of age and younger only!**
All other individuals must register separately!

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR USE OF FACILITIES

Members shall assist the employees in making the facilities safe and enjoyable places by abiding by the following rules and regulations:

Obey the lifeguard's instructions.

Walk - do not run on the beach or around the pool areas.

No wrestling, horseplay, punching, pulling or pushing others into the water.

Snapping of towels is prohibited.

Toys, rubber balls, inner tubes and snorkels are not permitted.

Persons using artificial swimming aids are directed to the shallow area. Only Coast Guard approved floatation devices may be used.

Dogs and other pets are not permitted on the grounds.

Diving is permitted only in designated areas. Only one person at a time shall use the diving board.

Persons using the diving board shall not make repetitive springs on the board.

No glass containers shall be permitted within the park areas.

Swimming under the dock is prohibited.

Card tables, umbrellas, beach chairs, chaise lounges, baby carriages and playpens shall be permitted only in designated areas.

Any person showing evidence of skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease, excessive sunburn, open blisters, or cuts, shall be refused admission. Any person wearing bandages or first aid dressings at any time shall not use the water facilities.

Children shall not be permitted to carry water from the area to make mud holes or cause untidiness around the beach or playground area.

Smoking is prohibited within the facilities

Spitting, expectorating is prohibited.

Persons using deep water areas must be competent swimmers. A swim test may be required.

Rubbish, paper, and all debris shall be deposited in the proper containers placed around the facilities. Please recycle.

Only swim diapers with rubber pants covering them along with a bathing suit are acceptable for small children who are not potty trained.

Clothing left in locker rooms must be in designated areas.

Stones, sticks, dirt, trash or other objects shall not be thrown into the water.

THE USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT THE FACILITIES IS PROHIBITED

Eating shall be permitted only in the designated areas.

Automobiles, bicycles, motor bikes and other conveyances shall be parked only in designated areas.

Please have your ID with you when using the facilities. Photo ID's will be issued for all members and must be shown to enter the swim facilities.

Please wash all sand off before using indoor showers or before entering the pool.

Failure to adhere to the afore-mentioned rules and all rules posted at the facility or to the decisions of the Facility Director may be cause for suspension or revocation of membership privileges (per Ordinance 31 of 2009).

SWIMMING PROGRAM

Each member will be issued a photo ID tag which must be shown for entrance to the facility.

Membership refunds will only be given prior to the opening of the season and only in the event that the member is moving or for serious health problems documented by a physician's letter.

All children one (1) year of age by May 1 must purchase a membership.

Lost ID's must be reported to the Department of Parks & Recreation immediately. Upon the payment of a fee, a new ID will be issued

ID's Are Non-Transferable

The transferring of ID's is a violation of Township Ordinance and will result in the suspension of the individuals involved. Subsequent violations will result in revocation of membership for the season.

Guest passes may only be purchased in the Recreation Office and used by the members of the family that purchased them. They are not transferable. Members must accompany their guests at all times that their guests are using the facility.

Guest passes are non-refundable.

Any member 62 years of age or older is entitled to reduced rate membership.

No child under thirteen years of age is permitted to use the facilities unless accompanied by a parent, or an adult, eighteen years of age or older, at all times while at the facilities. A child will be considered thirteen years of age as long as his thirteenth birthday occurs prior to Independence Day of the current year.

Parents leaving children unattended under thirteen years of age, and not remaining with them within the limits of the facilities will be notified that they are in violation of the rules of the facility. Additional violations may result in suspensions and then revocation of memberships for the entire family.

Failure to adhere to the afore-mentioned rules and all rules posted at the facility or to the decisions of the Facility Director may be cause for suspension or revocation of membership privileges (per Ordinance 31 of 2009).

Registrants using false Wayne addresses on their application will forfeit their entire membership.

SWIM FACILITIES

The swim facilities have buildings which contain hot showers, dressing rooms, lockers, restrooms, and refreshment stands. The recreation areas have ballfields, badminton, volleyball and basketball courts, bocci & horseshoes (pool only), shuffleboard or playground equipment.

Hours of operation for the facilities are as follows:

Opening Day to mid or late June-
12:00 Noon- 6:00 P.M.

Mid or late June to early August-
12:00 Noon- 8:00 P.M.

Early August to Labor Day-
12:00 Noon - 7:00 P.M.

Weekends and Holidays-
11:00 A.M. Opening

NOTE: The swim facilities will close 15 minutes early to allow for beach and pool area clean-up. Locker rooms will close promptly at posted closing time.

Lifeguard whistle codes are as follows:

1 Short Blast-to get the attention of a swimmer

2 Short Blasts-a guard is leaving his/her stand for a rescue

1 Long Blast-to clear the water

CLOSING THE FACILITIES-IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

The swimming supervisor or facility director shall have the authority to close the facilities in inclement weather or whenever in his judgement, the health or safety of members is in jeopardy.

SWIMMING LESSONS

Members may register for children's swimming lessons at the facility they join. Fees for swim lessons are listed on registration form.

Children will be assigned to a half hour or 45 minute lesson each weekday beginning approximately 10:00 A.M. and ending at 12:00 Noon

Members must leave the facility at the conclusion of their swim lessons. Towels left on lounges to "SAVE" them for when the pool opens will be removed and placed in the lost and found.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Sign ups for all sessions will be posted at facilities. The child must have a seasonal membership to qualify for lessons.

Note: Register early as lessons frequently fill quickly.
