2010 Public Works Bulletin

Includes July - December Recycling Collection Dates & Related Information June, 2010

In the last two Public Works Bulletins, I have tried to provide an overview of the Department and to offer advice on if or when permits are necessary. Some of the most common problems are:

Landscaping

In general, maintenance of your lawn and property does not require a permit. All too often what starts as a minor idea expands to a project which requires a permit.

- Planting of shrubs, reseeding of the lawn - No Permit
- Disturbance of more than 250 square feet - Grading Permit required
- Wall construction over 6 inches - Grading Permit required
- If wall exceeds 4' 0" - Construction Permit required
- Any drainage, roof leader piping, or dry wells - Grading Permit required
- Tree removal of four or more trees - Permit required

You should speak with any potential contractors and make sure each understands the scope of the project. If there are any questions, call the Engineering offices at 973-694-1800 ext. 3263. A marked-up copy of your survey showing the planned work will aid in understanding the project and delineating the limits of approvals. It is best if the contractor obtains any permits, then he/she will be primarily responsible. If you, as the homeowner, obtains a permit, you will be primarily responsible. It is always best to ask questions before construction starts, than to have a problem in the middle of the project.

Sheds, Fences, Decks or Pools

Any of these require a Zoning Permit. A copy of your survey should be marked-up showing the location and distance to any rear or side property lines. All residential zones have minimum set backs and a shed, deck, or pool must not fall within these set backs. A fence may be located on the property line, but there are zone criteria for fences. You should speak with the Zoning Official at 973-694-1800 ext. 3320 before any activities to assure compliance and Zoning Permit, if necessary. Variances from zone criteria can be obtained if approved by the Board of Adjustment. This process takes time and special circumstances must be presented. Before considering this option, we strongly recommend you speak to the Zoning Official.

House Additions and Modifications

Excepting for minor interior in-kind improvements or repairs (painting, wall papering, etc.) a Construction Permit is necessary. This is established by the State's Uniform Construction Code (UCC). All construction standards, reviews, and inspections must comply with the UCC. Before any work, we recommend you contact the Construction Code Official at 973-694-1800 ext. 3337 to understand the requirements. Most particularly, any electrical, plumbing, or structural changes must receive a permit.

If you plan to modify the use of a room (create a bathroom, finish-off the basement, etc.) this will require a permit. This permit is actually for your benefit. If changes are made without a permit and a problem develops (fire or flood), and the insurance company becomes aware that permits were not obtained, they may deny coverage. Speak to your potential contractor. They must be licensed by the State, and they must know the law. If the contractor obtains the permits, he/she will be held responsible for their work.

Garage Sales

A permit is required for a garage, yard, or estate sale. Up to two permits are allowed per year. They are good for the scheduled weekend, plus the next weekend (rain date). Posting of signs is limited to your front yard. Permits are issued over the counter in the Construction Code Office for a fee of \$5.00.

These permits are for your benefit, for the safety of the Township in general, and to maintain the character of the neighborhood. If you have any questions, please call the appropriate Township staff. I also would remind you that all contractors are required to be licensed by the State. This licensing is intended to afford another level of review to protect the homeowner. If a contractor can not produce proof of this State License, I suggest you consider other options.

Flood Awareness Information

Wayne Township is located in the Passaic River Basin, which is a 650 square miles area from Harriman, New York to south of Morristown, New Jersey. Wayne is located approximately in the center where the Ramapo, Pompton, Pequannock and Passaic Rivers merge. The southern portion of Wayne that lies along the rivers is likely to experience some kind of flooding on a fairly regular basis. Whether it be nuisance flooding, where streets and low lying properties have surface water accumulation or major river flooding, where homes become flooded, unlivable and residents must be evacuated. When or how often an area becomes flooded can not be predicted. It does not matter what type of flooding occurs, when floods occur, a dangerous condition exists for all residents located in the flooded areas. Flood waters are unpredictable and know no boundaries. They can quickly inundate an entire area. It is very important for all affected residents to heed all flood warnings issued and follow all instructions.

Residents living in low lying areas should be prepared for flooding at all times. An "Emergency Kit" should be kept stocked for Flood Emergencies. The items that should be included in the Kit are: a flashlight and spare batteries - a battery operated radio - 3 gallons of water per person - a first aid kit - personal hygiene items. Residents should know the location of the electric breaker box, fuel oil valve, gas valve, water valve and know how to shut them off. Keep a list of all items that require moving to keep them out of flood waters. Keep a list of personal items that have to be taken with you if evacuation is necessary and don't forget your medicines. Plan for pet relocation until the emergency is over.

What to do when a Flood Emergency is declared

When a Flood Emergency is declared, emergency vehicles with public address systems will be dispatched to affected areas to notify residents what they should do. The Township also activates the emergency notification system and will call residents. Information can also be obtained from the Emergency Management Center at 97-694-5050 and on WMC-TV77 Wayne cable channel 77. Residents should keep in contact with their neighbors to make sure they are aware of the advisories. If possible, do not walk or drive through floodwaters. These waters may be contaminated or be hiding dangerous objects beneath the water. All vehicles should be moved to higher ground and any loose objects should be secured so they don't float away. Important papers should be placed in a watertight container to take with you if evacuation is necessary.

What to do when an Evacuation Order is issued

Turn off gas, fuel oil, water and electric. Provide for flood water to enter and exit the cellar or basement through open windows or doors. This relieves the flood pressure against your walls, so they don't collapse. Do not leave your important papers behind. Leave immediately, so you don't get stranded by floodwaters. If you cannot get out safely because the road is flooded, call the Emergency Operating Center for assistance at 973-694-5050. You should seek shelter with relative or friends or the nearest designated Emergency Shelter. If one is opened.

What to do when you return home

Be aware of any pavement that has been undermined or dislodged, debris or sinkholes. Do not touch any loose wires as they may be charged. Do not smoke or have an open flame when entering buildings. Contact your utility company before turning gas, electric or water back on. An inspection should be performed by the Wayne Building Department. Any septic system that has been under water should not be used. If used, contamination of floodwaters can occur. Wells should not be used until they have been disinfected. Wells should be tested prior to use to verify that no coliforms are present. Call the Wayne Health Department at 973-694-1800 ext 3241 for further information.

National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP)

Through Wayne Township's participation in the NFIP Community Rating System, Wayne residents automatically receive a 10% discount on their flood insurance policy. The Increased Cost of Compliance Program can provide up to \$30,000.00 to bring flood damaged homes to current FEMA, State and Wayne Township flood regulations. Funds can be used to elevate, demolish or relocate residential buildings after a flood that causes at least 50% damage to the building or where the building has received 25% damage at least 2 times in 10 years.

Solid Waste & Recycling Info

- ◆ Solid Waste, Recycling & Vegetative Waste must be at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection
- ◆ Solid Waste, Recycling & Vegetative Waste Containers and White Goods & Scrap Metals Must **NOT** Be Placed at the Curb More Than 24 Hours Prior to Your Scheduled Collection Date
- ◆ Commingled Recycling includes: Glass Bottles & Jars, Food, Beverage & Pet Food Cans, and All Plastics. This includes all plastic bottles, containers, polystyrene containers & packing peanuts, bottle caps, shrink wrap, plastic pipes, solid plastic outdoor furniture & plastic toys (remove any metal parts). Do Not Include: window glass, light bulbs, plates, ceramics, china, crystal, mirrored glass, aerosol cans, paint cans, chemical cans, foil or food wrappers.
- ◆ Mixed Paper & Corrugated/Cardboard Box Recycling includes: Newspapers, Books, Junk Mail, Magazines, Periodicals, Letters & Envelopes, Scrap Paper and Dry Food Boxes. Place in brown paper grocery bags or put into a sturdy corrugated box or tie in a bundle that can be reasonable lifted by one person. Do Not Include: used paper plates, cups or towels, soiled papers, wax coated milk, juice or food containers.
- ◆ Do Not include any Plastic Bags with Mixed Paper & Corrugated Recycling
- ◆ Recyclables & Vegetative Waste Must Not Be Placed at Curb in Plastic Bags.
- ◆ Recycle Plastic Bags at Your Local Grocery Store
- ◆ Large, Non-Metal Bulk Items such as Furniture, Large Televisions, Carpets, Scrap Wood and Other Large Odds & Ends Are Garbage and Should be Put Out on Your **First or Second Solid Waste Collection of the Month (Maximum of 3 Items)**
- ◆ Construction materials must be disposed of privately. If you are doing a SMALL repair, a container of debris or some doors or windows can be handled as bulk items on the 1st or 2nd solid waste collection of each month. Wood scraps should be no more than 4' - 5' long, with nails removed & tied in bundles or in container that one person can lift & dump.
All other construction debris requires private disposal.
- ◆ Largest size container permitted for recycling & garbage is 35 gallons, max. 50 lbs.
Largest size container permitted for vegetative waste is 32 gallons
Any recycling or vegetative waste in larger containers will **NOT** be collected.
DO NOT OVERFILL CONTAINER, One person must be able to lift and dump
- ◆ Solid Waste, Recyclables & Vegetative Waste Will Be Collected Rain or Shine. In the Event of Heavy Snowfall or Flooding Conditions, Collection May Be Canceled Until Your Next Scheduled Date. If This Occurs, It Will Be Announced on WMC - TV77 & WGHT -1500 AM
