SWIMMING PROGRAM

Each member will be issued a photo ID tag which must be shown for entrance to the facility.

Membership refunds will only be given prior to the opening of the season and only in the event that the member is moving or for serious health problems documented by a physician's letter.

All children one (1) year of age by May 1 must purchase a membership.

Lost IDs must be reported to the Department of Parks & Recreation immediately. Upon the payment of a fee, a new ID will be issued.

IDs Are Non-Transferable. The transferring of IDs is a violation of Township Ordinance and will result in the suspension of the individuals involved. Subsequent violations will result in revocation of membership for the season.

Guest passes may only be purchased in the Recreation Office and used by the members of the family that purchased them. They are not transferable. Members must accompany their guests at all times that their guests are using the facility. Guest passes are non-refundable.

Any member 62 years of age or older is entitled to reduced rate membership.

No child under thirteen years of age is permitted to use the facilities unless accompanied by a parent, or an adult, eighteen years of age or older, at all times while at the facilities. A child will be considered thirteen years of age as long as his thirteenth birthday occurs prior to Independence Day of the current year.

Parents leaving children unattended under thirteen years of age, and not remaining with them within the limits of the facilities will be notified that they are in violation of the rules of the facility. Additional violations may result in suspensions and then revocation of memberships for the entire family.

Failure to adhere to the afore-mentioned rules and all rules posted at the facility or to the decisions of the Facility Director may be cause for suspension or revocation of membership privileges per Ordinance 16 of 2009.

Registrants using false Wayne addresses on their application will forfeit their entire membership.

SWIM FACILITIES

The swim facilities have buildings which contain hot showers, dressing rooms, lockers, restrooms, and refreshment stands. The recreation areas have ball fields, badminton, volleyball and basketball courts, bocci & horseshoes (pool only), shuffleboard or playground equipment.

Hours of operation for the facilities are as follows:

- Opening Day to mid or late June, 12:00 Noon- 6:00 P.M.
- Mid or late June to early August, 12:00 Noon- 8:00 P.M.
- Early August to Labor Day, 12:00 Noon - 7:00 P.M.
- Weekends and Holidays, 11:00 A.M. Opening

NOTE: The swim facilities will close 15 minutes early to allow for beach and pool area clean-up. Locker rooms will close promptly at posted closing time.

CLOSING THE FACILITIES IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

The swimming supervisor or facility director shall have the authority to close the facilities in inclement weather or whenever in his judgment, the health or safety of members is in jeopardy.

SWIMMING LESSONS

Members may register for children's swimming lessons at the facility they join.

Fees for swim lessons are listed on registration form.

Children will be assigned to a half hour or 45 minute lesson each weekday beginning approximately 10:00 A.M. and ending at 12:00 Noon

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Signups for all sessions will be posted at facilities. The child must have a seasonal membership to qualify for lessons.

Note: Register early as lessons frequently fill quickly.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR USE OF FACILITIES

Members shall assist the employees in making the facilities safe and enjoyable places by abiding by the following rules and regulations:

- Obey the lifeguard's instructions.
- Walk - do not run on the beach or around the pool areas.
- No wrestling, horseplay, punching, pulling or pushing others into the water.
- Snapping of towels is prohibited.
- Toys, rubber balls, inner tubes and snorkels are not permitted.
- Persons using artificial swimming aids are directed to the shallow area. Only Coast Guard approved floatation devices may be used.
- Dogs and other pets are not permitted on the grounds.
- Diving is permitted only in designated areas. Only one person at a time shall use the diving board.
- Persons using the diving board shall not make repetitive springs on the board.
- No glass containers shall be permitted within the park areas.
- Card tables, umbrellas, beach chairs, chaise lounges, baby carriages and playpens shall be permitted only in designated areas.
- Any person showing evidence of skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease, excessive sunburn, open blisters, or cuts, shall be refused admission. Any person wearing bandages or first aid dressings at any time shall not use the water facilities.
- Children shall not be permitted to carry water from the area to make mud holes or cause untidiness around the beach or playground area.
- Smoking is prohibited within the facilities.
- Spitting, expectorating is prohibited.
- Persons using deep water areas must be competent swimmers. A swim test may be required.
- Rubbish, paper, and all debris shall be deposited in the proper containers placed around the facilities. Please recycle.
- Only swim diapers with rubber pants covering them along with a bathing suit are acceptable for small children.
- Clothing left in locker rooms must be in designated areas.
- Stones, sticks, dirt, trash or other objects shall not be thrown into the water.
- **THE USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT THE FACILITIES IS PROHIBITED**
- Eating shall be permitted only in the designated areas.
- Automobiles, bicycles, motor bikes and other conveyances shall be parked only in designated areas.
- Please have your ID with you when using the facilities. Photo IDs will be issued for all members and must be shown to enter the swim facilities.
- Please wash all sand off before using indoor showers or before entering the pool.
- Failure to adhere to the afore-mentioned rules and all rules posted at the facility or to the decisions of the Facility Director may be cause for suspension or revocation of membership privileges per Ordinance 16 of 2009.
