**BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township of Wayne, in the County of Passaic, State of New Jersey on **April 21, 2010** and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: **BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE 2010 SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WAYNE, IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$395,000 THEREFORE AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$376,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF.**

Purpose(s): The improvement of sidewalks of the Township by removal and replacement of existing sidewalks and aprons having raised beyond the state of repair, due to Township-owned trees or sidewalk abutting on Township-owned land, including all landscape and pavement restoration and appurtenances necessary therefore and including all work, design and materials necessary therefore and incidental thereto, all as show on and in accordance with the specifications to be prepared and filed in the office of the Township Clerk and hereby approved.
