**TOWNSHIP OF WAYNE**  
**COUNTY OF PASSAIC**  
**STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DEDICATION OF  
CERTAIN LAND WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF WAYNE FOR  
A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.**

**WHEREAS**, Thomas Longo, owner of Block 1904, Lot 183, commonly known as 2 Donna Lane, has received approval of a minor subdivision that requires the construction of a cul-de-sac; and

**WHEREAS**, Thomas Longo has requested that the Township dedicate a portion of Township owned land more commonly known as Block 1904, Lot 167.01, to be used as a public right-of-way for the construction of a cul-de-sac on Donna Lane.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Municipal Council of the Township of Wayne in the County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The following described lands owned by the Township of Wayne are hereby formally adopted, accepted, opened and laid out as a public highway of said Township and dedicated as a public right-of-way:

**BEGINNING** at a point in the southerly line of Donna Lane at its terminus at Lot 183, Block 1904, as shown on Filed Map No. 2526,

1. Along a curve to the right having a radius of 102.54 feet, along the southerly line of Donna Lane, an arc length of 38.80 feet, thence
2. South 48 degrees 28 minutes 10 seconds East, still along said southerly line of Donna Lane, 11.52 feet, thence
3. Along a curve to the left having a radius of 15.00 feet and an arc length of 18.68 feet, thence
4. Along a curve to the right having a radius of 40.00 feet, being the new cul-de-sac ROW of Donna Lane, an arc length of 39.67 feet, thence
5. North 26 degrees 09 minutes 20 seconds East, 29.79 to the point of beginning.

**SECTION 2.** If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as prescribed by law.
